Product Lifecycle Management (PLM) is the process of managing the entire lifecycle of a product from its conception through design and manufacture to service and disposal.

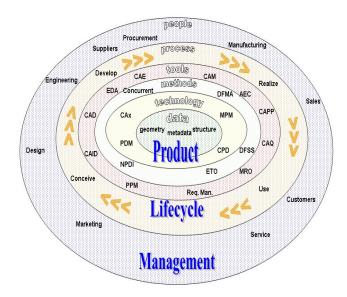


Figure 1: PLM Life Cycle

In Two-tier architecture the user can develop only Rich client customization. The server is working in his local PC. And the user can store the data in the database in the Local PC.

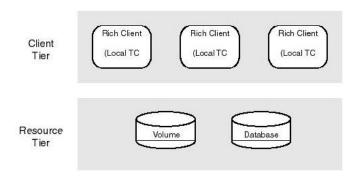


Figure 2: Two-tier Architecture

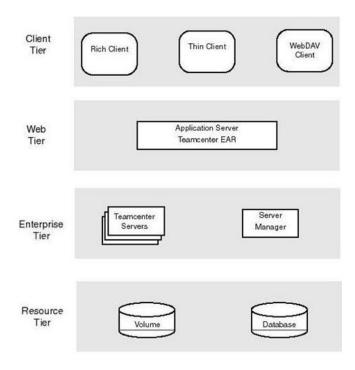


Figure 3 Four Tier Architecture

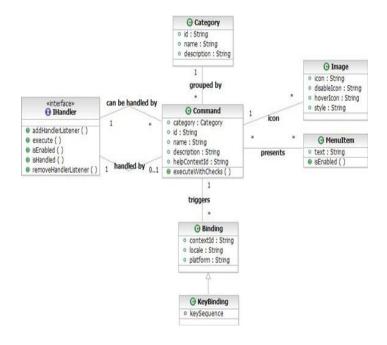


Figure 4: Command framework

When we press on the command the action is going to perform

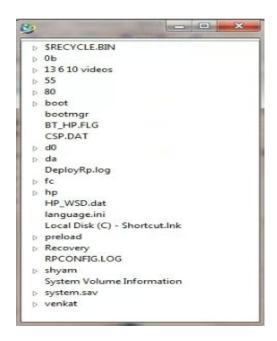


Figure 7: Final Result of Application
